


The course has been designed in conjunction with industry to ensure it meets the corporate finance skills needs of employers. Upon completion of the MSc Finance (Corporate Finance), students have excellent career prospects with business advisory, consultancy, corporate, investment banking and venture capital firms.

Students on the programme will gain insight into the financial sector through case studies, guest lectures from industry leaders and, as part of Mentor Week, the opportunity to work with internationally experienced Senior Executives. In addition, students focus on developing analytical and professional skills, culminating in a real-life corporate finance consultancy project.

This programme has been accepted into the CFA® Institute University Affiliation Programme and the CAIA® Academic Partner Programme. Upon graduation from the programme students also have exemptions from certain ACCA examinations.





PROFESSIONAL BODY EXEMPTION

The MSc Finance (Corporate Finance) programme has been accepted into the CFA® Institute University Recognition Programme and the CAIA® Academic Partner Programme. In addition upon graduation from the programme graduates gain exemptions from certain ACCA examinations.

The CFA® Institute University Recognition Programme status is granted to institutions whose degree program(s) incorporate at least 70% of the CFA® Program Candidate body of Knowledge (CBOK), which provide students with a solid grounding in the CBOK and positions them well to sit the CFA® exams.

The CAIA® academic partnership is granted to institutions who cover at least 60% of the entire CAIA® curriculum as represented by the Core Knowledge Outline (CKO). ACCA has also assessed the MSc Finance (Corporate Finance) for accreditation. Graduates of the programme will be exempted from sitting papers F1-F3.

PRACTICALITIES & ASSESSMENT

Practicalities

For the MSc Finance (Corporate Finance) degree, students will complete an induction week, 10 course modules, 5 core courses and 5 specialised modules, an industry lecture series and a team project.

The course can be completed full-time over 12 months, or part-time over 24 months.

Assessment

To meet the development objectives of the programme the MSc Finance (Corporate Finance) is assessed by a blend of formal examination and continuous assessment. Each module contains a minimum of 30% continuous assessment.

For the final element of the MSc Finance (Corporate Finance) students can complete is a research project or an industry relevant placement. This represents one third of the marks for the masters programme.

Irish/EU Students and International Students

Minimum 2H1 (GPA 3.25 out of 4.0) in a degree [NFQ Level 8] or equivalent in a business course, or a cognate discipline.

Applicants who achieve a 2H2 degree but meet all other requirements will be assessed on a case by case basis.

English Language Requirement:

IELTS: 6.5

With no individual section lower than 5.5

TOEFL: 90

With minimum scores as follows:

- Listening: 17 Reading: 18
- Speaking: 20 Writing: 17

Cambridge Proficiency Exam: Grade C Cambridge Advanced Exam: Grade B

Pearson PTE: Minimum Score of 63 With no section score below 59
