

Application Process

Application Requirements

The threshold entry requirements for the Programme are as follows:



A Second Class Honours Grade II in a primary honours degree (NFQ, Level 8) or equivalent (e.g. Higher Diploma) and at least 2 years of professional work experience.



Consideration under Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) may be given to applicants who do not fully meet the above criteria but who have significant senior professional experience in a related field such as engineering, construction, operations and software development.



Plus, all applicants are required to complete a supplementary form. Participants will be selected on the basis of the information supplied in their application and supplementary information.

The University reserve the right to interview applicants to help make determinations.
