- To comply with government guidelines for social distancing, teaching will be delivered in a blended fashion in 2020/2021. This means students will engage in both online learning (live online events and pre-made online content) and on-campus learning (in-person sessions at UCC). For on campus, face-to-face lectures students will be allocated to pods of 50 or less and rotate on and off campus at times assigned. Details of the assigned times will be communicated prior to the

commencement of the semester. Under current guidelines, students should not expect to spend more than 4 hours per week on campus depending on the week and group assigned.

- All lectures will be recorded and available online through the university's Virtual Learning Environment, Canvas, to be accessed by students on the days when they are not on campus and to facilitate students who cannot be physically present.
