All timetables are provisional and subject to change in line with government and NPHET guidelines in the context of Covid-19. Full timetables are currently being released.

To comply with government guidelines for social distancing, teaching will be delivered in a blended fashion in 2020/2021. This means students will engage in both online learning (live online events and pre-produced online content) and on-campus learning (in-person sessions at UCC).

For on campus, face-to-face lectures, students will be allocated to pods of 50 or less and rotate on and off campus on the day assigned. Details of the assigned day and start and end times for each programme are provided in the table above. **Some programmes will operate a weekly rotation of pods.**

Tutorials/Practicals will also be provided in addition to this schedule, details of which are still to be finalised and may include a range of mechanisms such as for example (online demos, case studies, quizzes, live Q&A and possibly some on campus activity).

All lectures will be recorded and available online through the university's Virtual Learning Environment, Canvas, to be accessed by students on the days when they are not on campus and to facilitate students who cannot be physically present.
